Re: Agricultural Tire Recycling Program

This is to advise that the Harford County Bureau of Solid Waste Management will be accepting tires from Harford County Farmers at **no charge** on the following dates only: May 15, 16, 17, 18, & 19, 2023 at the Harford Waste Disposal Center (HWDC) located at 3241 Scarboro Road, Street, MD 21154 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. each day.

All tires must be delivered by the Farmer to HWDC. **A copy of this letter must be brought with each load of tires.** Upon arrival, each load must weighed in at the scales and checked. You will also weigh out so we can track the tonnage coming in.

There is a limit of 283 tons of tires that can be accepted under this program. It is strongly recommended that the Farmers call 410-638-3417 for a status of tire recycling acceptance before leaving your farm. Once the limit has been reached, we will no longer be able to accept tires under this program.

Passenger, light truck, and agricultural tires
On or off rims accepted
Farms only – all other businesses prohibited!**
