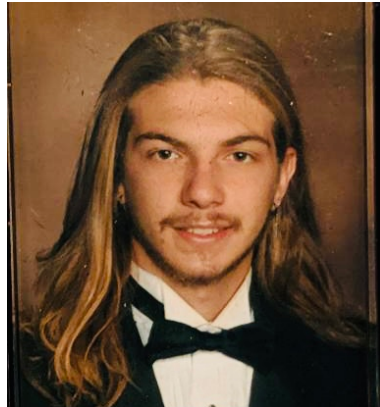
Jane Godfrey
