# Anne Arundel County Farm Bureau Scholarship

(For a student planning to earn an agriculture or agricultural related degree.)

#### The Scholarship Award

- ~ The amount of the scholarship is \$2,000 per year.
- ~ The scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university.
- ~ The scholarship will be awarded to the winning recipient for a maximum of 4 years providing the AACFB is financially able to renew the scholarship. If the recipient earns a Bachelor's degree in less than 4 years, the scholarship will be terminated at that time.
- ~ Scholarship recipients will be approved by the AACFB Board of Directors at their May meeting.

#### **Eligibility requirements:**

- ~ If awarded, parent or student must be (or become) a member of Anne Arundel County Farm Bureau. Membership can be acquired through MFB at <a href="www.mdfarmbureau.com">www.mdfarmbureau.com</a>.
- ~ Must be a graduating high school senior or college student.
- ~ Must plan to attend full-time to any community or 4-year college.
- ~ Must be registered in an agriculture or agricultural related curriculum.

#### Scholarship candidates must submit:

- ~ Scholarship application typed in 12 pt font and underlined.
- ~ High school or college transcript
- ~ Two letters of recommendation at least one from a teacher with knowledge of the student's academic background.
- ~ A letter giving the reasons why you have selected your program of study and your future plans.
- ~ A printout of the course requirements for the degree you have chosen or include the web link on the application.

### Scholarship recipient:

- ~ A \$2,000 check will be sent to the college before each fall semester.
- ~ At the end of each spring semester, the scholarship recipient is responsible for submitting an unofficial copy of their transcript, which includes the cumulative GPA, to the secretary of the AA Co Farm Bureau. The following year's payment will not be sent until this is received.
- ~ Must remain in an agriculture or agricultural related curriculum with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better. If these 2 requirements are not met, it will be the decision of the Scholarship Committee to retract future scholarship payments.
