Scholarships & Grant

Don Schwartz Memorial Agricultural Scholarship: (\$2,000 - Post-Secondary Education) One (1) \$2,000 scholarship may be awarded annually for a major in Agricultural Science with an emphasis on animal or plant sciences. Funds can be used for tuition and/or books and may be sent to the student or directly to the college or university the recipient is attending.

<u>Washington County Farm Bureau Scholarship</u>: (\$1,000 - Post-Secondary Education) Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships may be awarded annually. Funds can be used for tuition and/or books and may be sent to the student or directly to the college, university or trade the recipient is attending.

Priorities for either scholarship:

- 1. The individual or his/her parent/guardian must be a member of Washington County (Maryland) Farm Bureau
- 2. Be a Washington County, Maryland resident
- 3. Be graduating high school or full-time college student in good academic standing with a transcript provided
- 4. Completed application
- 5. Submit an essay of a maximum of 500 words on the applicant's agricultural background and experiences, including 4-H, FFA, farm, and school experiences (attach with application)
- 6. Submit an essay of a maximum of 500 words on your chosen field of study and what you hope to do (attach with application)
- 7. Submit two (2) letters of reference (no relatives, attach with application)
- 8. Complete a personal interview with Washington County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee (if committee requests)
- 9. Winner may be asked to speak at Farm Bureau functions

<u>Washington County Farm Bureau Grant</u>: One (1) grant may be awarded up to \$1,000 to an individual who is pursuing a new enterprise or business venture relating to agriculture and for which they are financially responsible.

Priorities for grant:

- 1. The individual or his/her parent/guardian must be a member of Washington County (Maryland) Farm Bureau
- 2. Be a Washington County, Maryland resident
- 3. Be between 17 and 25 years of age
- 4. Completed application
- 5. Submit a Business Plan with a written explanation of the Enterprise of Business Venture
- 6. Must submit two (2) letters of reference (no relatives, attach with application)
- 7. Must complete a personal interview with Washington County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee (if committee requests)
- 8. Winner may be asked to speak at Farm Bureau functions
- 9. Grant may be paid directly to venders of supplies if materials are needed in pursuit of venture
